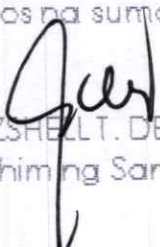

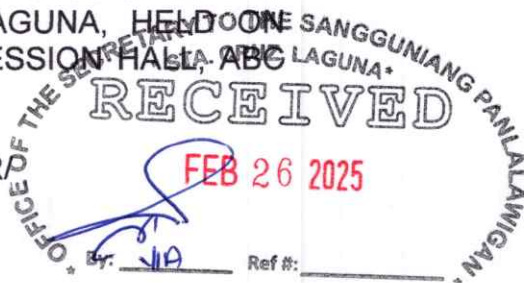
AN ORDINANCE STRENGTHENING THE KATARUNGANG PAMBARANGAY SYSTEM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAVINTI, ESTABLISHING THE SUPPORT PROGRAM AND FOR THAT PURPOSE THE FEDERATION OF LUPONG TAGAPAMAYAPA OF CAVINTI, MANDATING THE CONTINUING EDUCATION OF ITS MEMBERS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the creation of the Lupong Tagapamayapa by virtue of the Local Government Code of 1991 plays a vital role in the Philippine Judicial system and is considered as among the most effective and most efficient mechanisms in resolving disputes among individuals, avoiding the animosity caused by long, expensive and usually delayed court cases between members of the community and, consequently, improving the quality of justice in our society;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code provides that the Municipal Government shall be responsible for the implementation of the Katarungang Pambarangay in all barangays within the jurisdiction, and to provide funds to support the same;

WHEREAS, Section 421 of Republic Act No. 7160, provides that the chief executive shall ensure the efficient and effective implementation and administration of the Katarungang Pambarangay;

WHEREAS, Section 422 of the same law states that such amount as may be necessary for the effective implementation of the Katarungang Pambarangay shall be provided for in the Municipal Annual Budget;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Department of Justice (DOJ) conduct the Lupong Tagapamayapa Incentive Awards annually which seeks to give due recognition to Lupons which have showed exemplary performance in exercising the time-honored tradition of amicably settling disputes among barangay constituents;

WHEREAS, the Municipal government of Cavinti will boost the performance of all Lupong Tagapamayapa in the Municipality by encouraging them to be among the best in the region or in the country pursuant to the criteria set by the DILG and DOJ and through giving them additional incentives by meeting the same;

WHEREAS, the creation of a Lupon Federation in the Municipality is essential to improve the implementation of strengthening the justice system in the grassroots level. It would envision a peaceful and progressive community brought about by competent Lupons who would help community members resolve conflicts amicably and dispense justice in a professional way;

WHEREAS, with a working Barangay Justice system IN PLACE, IT WOULD RESULT TO A MORE HARMONIOUS AND PEACEFUL ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE WHICH COULD HELP A COMMUNITY SURMOUNTED WITH FILES OF COURT CASES BARELY MOVING THAT CAN EASILY BE RESOLVED THROUGH THE GRASSROOTS JUSTICE SYSTEM;

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE, as it is hereby, **RESOLVED**, that this Ordinance shall be enacted.

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "The Katarungang Pambarangay Ordinance of the Municipality of Cavinti."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. The Municipality of Cavinti fully subscribes to the National government's policies and programs relative to the Katarungang Pambarangay or Barangay Justice System. The strengthening enhancement and effective implementation of the same in local governments is imperative in order to ensure that disputes and conflicts are resolved in the barangay level, thereby helping in eliminating congestion of cases in the judicial court system. The same is also essential in warranting a speedy, just, impartial and reliable disposition of disputes among community members in the promotion of peaceful and harmonious relationships.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. **KATARUNGANG PAMBARANGAY OR BARANGAY JUSTICE SYSTEM-** is a Barangay-Based mechanism of amicably settling disputes between members of the same community through the intervention of their peers – the Punong Barangay and the members of the Lupong Tagapamayapa.
- b. **Lupong Tagapamayapa or Lupon** – is the body organized in every barangay composed of Punong Barangay as the chairperson and not less than ten (10) and more than twenty (20) from which the members of every Pangkat shall be chosen;
- c. **Lupon Chairman-** The Punong Barangay is the head of Lupong Tagapamayapa;
- d. **Pangkat ng Tagapagkasundo (Pangkat)-** is a conciliation panel constituted from the Lupon membership for every dispute brought before the Lupon consisting of three(3) members after the Punong Barangay has failed in his mediation efforts;
- e. **Amicable Settlement-** is an agreement reached during mediation and conciliation proceedings;
- f. **Arbitration-** is a process wherein the third party from outside the judicial system is chosen by parties to hear and decide their dispute;
- g. **Conciliation-** is a process wherein the Pangkat forgoes the power to decide or recommend but assist the parties to isolate issues and options to reach a settlement by consensus that jointly satisfies their needs;
- h. **Execution-** is the process of exacting satisfaction for to or both of the parties through compulsory or coercive means. It entails the enforcement of the terms of the amicable settlement or arbitration award in so far as this may enjoin or command any of the parties to perform an act, give something or refrain from doing some act;
- i. **Jurisdiction-** is an authority to hear and decide a case and given by law and cannot be agreed by the parties;
- j. **Mediation-** is a process wherein the Lupon chairperson or Barangay Chairperson assists the disputing parties to reach a settlement by consensus that jointly satisfies their needs;
- k. **Venue-** is the place where the case is to be heard and decided. This is not fixed by law except in criminal cases, and can be agreed upon by the parties.

SECTION 4. INCORPORATION CLAUSE. The provisions of the Katarungang Pambarangay Law from Sections 399 to 422, Chapter 7, Title One Book III and Section 515, Title One, Book IV of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 together with the Katarungang Pambarangay Rules promulgated pursuant thereto are hereby considered written in this ordinance. Notwithstanding the established rules and procedures, the Lupong Tagapamapa is encouraged to be more innovative in the manner and ways of settling disputes cognizable by Lupon to ensure that peace in the community is truly promoted and harmonious relationships among community members is restored and/or maintained.

SECTION 5. THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE. Pursuant to Section 421 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the municipal mayor shall be in the forefront of ensuring the efficient and effective implementation and administration of the Katarungang Pambarangay or Barangay Justice System in the NINETEEN (19) barangays of the Municipality. In the discharge of such mandate, he shall be assisted by the Lupon Federation Officers .

SECTION 6. THE LUPON OFFICERS AND ITS FUNCTIONS. Support is officially given for the organization and continuous growth of the Lupon Federation of Nineteen (19) Lupong Tagapamayapa in the Municipality with the following purposes:

1. To solicit active participation and ensure full cooperation among Lupon members for causes beneficial to the people as well as to the members themselves;
2. To coordinate Lupong Tagapamayapa affairs, including the conduct of a continuing education seminar or skills training by its members;
3. To provide Lupon members a venue for constructive discussion of the needs and problems affecting them and the people they serve;
4. To assist the city and the barangay in the efficient and effective implementation and administration of the Katarungang Pambarangay; and
5. To approve and implement policies, projects, programs and activities for the welfare and upliftment of all the personnel involved in the implementation of the Lupong Tagapamayapa.

SECTION 7. THE FEDERATION OFFICERS AND ADVISERS. The responsible officials of the Lupon Federation who shall carry out the above functions and address operational issues shall consist of the President or representatives of each of the Nineteen(19) Lupong Tagapamayapa in the Municipality. From said group the executive officers shall be elected composed of the following:

- (1) President,;
- (2) Vice-President;
- (3) Secretary,;

- (4) Treasurer;
- (5) Auditor;
- (6) Public Information Officer;
- (7) Two (2) Business Managers;
- (8) Two (2) Liaison Officers; and

The remaining Nine (9) shall automatically become the members of the Board.

The federation shall assist the Municipal Mayor in the efficient and effective implementation and administration of the Katarungang Pambarangay. It shall take legal and directional guidance from a lawyer in the Sangguniang Bayan who shall be its legal adviser or, in his absence, from the Municipal Legal Counsel. (The adviser's personnel shall assist the federation in all the operational and secretariat requirements of the federation shall be provided by the adviser's personnel.

SECTION 8. SEMINARS AND TRAININGS. To ensure that Lupon Chairmen, Members, Secretaries and Process Servers are conversant with the applicable law, rules, regulations and jurisprudence as well as possessing of the necessary mediation, conciliation, arbitration, counseling and appropriate skills, the conduct of a seminar and/or training for the purpose is herein mandated on a continuing basis every time the Lupon in each barangay is constituted and thereafter during the term of its members.

Thus, the following shall be conducted, to wit:

1. Within three (3) months after the constitution of all the Lupon, a Capability Building Seminar for all Punong Barangays, Lupon Members and Barangay Secretaries which shall include discussion on the Katarungang Pambarangay Law, Lupon Tagapamayapa, Parties, Jurisdiction and Venue, Procedure for Amicable Settlement, Mediation, Conciliation and Arbitration Execution and Katarungang Pambarangay Forms;
2. Within the same period, a seminar or training on the service of summons and other proceedings for process servers;
3. Thereafter, a seminar or a refreshers' course on Katarungang Pambarangay Updates and related jurisprudence; and
4. Such other trainings or seminars as may be necessary.

SECTION 9. PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES IN THE BARANGAY. Each Lupon Tagapamayapa is encouraged to undertake programs and activities in the barangay to effectively carry out its mandate as well as to enhance respect to its members and underscore the relevance and the nature of their works in the community. Displaying their names and photographs in conspicuous places in the barangay is advised.

SECTION 10. BARANGAY HONORARIUM. The Nineteen (19) barangays of this Municipality are mandated to allocate and grant an amount in

depends in their 55% Personnel Fund mentioned as honorarium based .It shall be incorporated in the annual budget of the barangay .

SECTION 11. FUNDING .Pursuant to the mandate of Section 422 of the ra 7160, the Municipality of Cavinti shall appropriate or set apart the amount of at least One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php100,000.00)For the Katarungang Pambarangay System or for the Federation of the Lupong Tagapamayapa of the Municipality, or for subject to augmentation as the need may arise and availability of funds.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any provision, section or any part of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction or suspended or revoked by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts hereof which shall remain and continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect after Fifteen (15) Days after this publication in the official website and Social Media Account of the Sangguniang Bayan and the Municipality of Cavinti or by posting in nineteen (19) Barangay Bulletin Board.

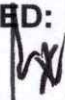

PAGTALAKAY SA PAKSA:

Binuksan ni SB Romel J. Villanueva ang Pampublikong Pagdinig sa ganap na ika-1:07 ng hapon. Bago dumako sa talakayan kung saan ay hiniling ng kagawad na bilang pagbibigay galang at paghingi ng patnubay sa ating mahal na Panginoon, kaya't ang lahat ay pinagsabi ng **Amen**.

Sa panimula ni SB Romel J. Villanueva ay pinasalamatan niya ang lahat-lahat ng nagsidalo sa patawag na ito sa pagbibigay ng sapat na oras upang makibahagi sa gagawing talakayan sa pagbabalangkas ng isang panukala na may kaugnayan sa Katarungang Pambarangay. Sang-ayon sa kanya ito ay panahon pa ng Marcos nagsimula at ginawa ang Act ukol rito noong magkaroon ng *Local Government Code of 1991*. Sinabi pa ng kagawad na ang mga inanyayahan sa Pampublikong Pagdinig na ito ay ang Punong Barangay/Lupon at mga *Secretary* ng Barangay dahil sila ang gumagampan kapag may usapin sa barangay. Paglilinaw din ni SB Romel J. Villanueva at itinanong kung alin na sa mga barangay ang mayroong gumaganap na Lupon *Head*? Sapagkat mayroon ng ilang barangay na may tumatayo ng *head*, kaya doon sa mga wala pang head at ipinayo niya na maglagay din sila dahil dapat ay may magli-lead sa pagharap ng mga usapin. Gayundin sa pagpapatawag ng munisipyo ay sila na lamang ang dadalo.

Sa pagpapatuloy ni SB Romel J. Villanueva, sinabi na sa pagbabalangkas ng ordinansa, kadalasan ang ginagawa ay babasahin ang nilalaman nito bago hingan ng suhestyon/opinyon kung sino ang may nais iparating sa hapag na may kaugnayan sa paksain. Ipinararating din niya na noong magpatawag ng *Committee Hearing*, kung kailan ay inimitahan na ang mga kinauukulan at nakapagbigay na rin sila ng karagdagang impormasyon para sa pagbuo ng ordinansa.

Tinunghayan ang sipi ng ordinansa at ito ay binasa ni SB Romel J. Villanueva ang ilang bahagi nito sa hapag. Matapos basahin ipinaliwanag din niya na ang DILG ay nagbaba ng direktiba na ito ang naging gabay/basehan para sa panukala ng Katarungang Pambarangay. Sinabi pa niya na ang DILG ay nakapagpatawag na rin noon sa mga kinauukulan upang pag-usapan ang tungkol sa Katarungang Pambarangay. Kaya para bigyan ng komento/suhestyon ang panukala, ibinukas ng kagawad ang hapag kung sino ang may nais iparating dito.

Sa kadahilanang ang ginamit na wika sa panukalang pinag-uusapan ay "English", kung saan ay hiniling ni G. Robert Villamin na kung maaari ay maisalin sa wikang Tagalog kahit iyong mga *basic*/mahahalagang detalye sa ordinansa upang sa ganoon ay maunawaan ng bawat isa.

Sang-ayon kay SB Romel J. Villanueva ang pinakabuod ng ordinansa ay nararanasan na ng marami at nagagawan naman ng aksyon. Kaya ayon sa kagawad ay mahalaga na magkaroon ng ganitong ordinansa upang ito ang pag-ugatan ng pagpapatawag ng lokal na pamahalaan.

Binigyang pansin sa talakayan ang gaya ng sumusunod:

A. Section 7. THE FEDERATION OFFICERS AND ADVISERS.

Sa ilalim nito sa huling talata nakasaad ang gaya ng sumusunod: *The federation shall assist the Municipal Mayor in the efficient and effective implementation and administration of the Katarungang Pambarangay. It shall take legal and directional guidance from a lawyer in the Sangguniang Bayan who shall be its legal adviser or, in his absence, from the Municipal Legal Counsel. (The adviser's personnel shall assist the federation in all its the operational and secretariat requirements of the federation shall be provided by the adviser's personnel.*

Sa bahaging ito ay binigyang kapunahan ang katagang **Municipal Legal Counsel**, dahil napagtanto ni SB Romel J. Villanueva na walang gumagampan ng ganito sa Sangguniang Bayan/Cavinti, kaya opinyon at suhestyon na rin ng kagawad na ang mas angkop na ilagay ay "**Municipal DILG Officer/Field Officer**".

Sinang-ayunan sa hapag ang opinyon/suhestyon ni SB Romel J. Villanueva.

B. Section 13. FUNDING.

Ipinararating ni SB Romel J. Villanueva sa hapag ang tungkol sa pondo para sa Katarungang Pambarangay na dati ay nagkakahalaga lamang ng P46,000.00 at sa ordinansa ay ginawa na itong P100,000.00. Sang-ayon sa kanya ang pondo ay manggagaling sa bawat barangay, kaya aniya'y mahalaga ang pagkakaroon ng ganitong ordinansa upang sa ganoon ay matulungan din ng lokal na pamahalaan.

Kaugnay sa paksa, ibinahagi ni G. Freddie Pornobe na noong siya ay lumahok sa isang pagsasanay na pinamunuan ng DILG kung kailan ay tinalakay ng isa sa *resource person* ay ang tungkol sa Lupong Tagapamayapa. Doon ay nabanggit na may batas na ang mga Punong Barangay ang siyang uupo/haharap sa paglilitis ngunit walang nabanggit na kailangang magharap sa barangay ng tatlong(3) beses bago ito gawan ng karampatang aksyon/ panibagong hakbang kapag hindi nagkasundo ang magkabilang panig. Ang sinabi ay dapat na papagkasunduin sa nalooban ng 15 araw at kapag hindi naayos sa barangay sa loob ng takdang panahon ay magbibigay pa ng panibagong 15 araw na *extension* at kapag hindi pa rin nagkaayos ay saka pa igagawa ng *endorsement*/gawan ng aksyon ayon sa hinihingi ng pangyayari. Dito ay ipinararating din niya na sa patawag na iyon ng DILG ay tanging ang taga-Barangay Silangan Talaongan ang may *participants* na barangay sa Cavinti. Kaya ayon kay G. Freddie Pornobe na dapat talaga ay magkaroon ng tulad ng ganitong pagsasanay ang lupon. Dahil aniya, ito ay napakahalaga sa pagganap ng tungkulin.

Ibinabalita rin ni SB Romel J. Villanueva na noong bago mag-*pandemic* ng siya ay nanungkulan pa sa barangay kung kailan ay nagkaroon ng Lupon Tagapamayapa Incentive Awards na ang barangay Poblacion ang naging pambato ng DILG. Aniya'y ang nasabing tanggapan ay nagbaba na rin ng panuntunan tungkol sa pagsasanay ng LTIA. Kaya ayon sa kagawad ay talagang mahalaga na ang mga Katarungang Pambarangay ay makadalo sa mga gagawing pagsasanay upang malaman nila ang tamang proseso sa pagharap nila sa mga usaping idinudulog sa barangay.

Paglilinaw ni G. Robert L. Villamin sa nabanggit ni G. Freddie Pornobe na base sa dinaluhan niyang *seminar* at itinanong ni G. Villamin kung halimbawa't doon sa sinasabing 15 days na palugit para ayusin ang usapin sa barangay, ano ang susunod na hakbang rito kapag lumipas na ang takdang panahon ay hindi pa nagkakasundo ang magkabilang panig?

Tugon ni G. 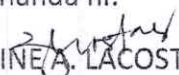

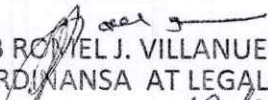

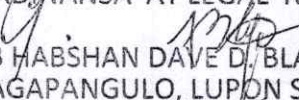
