MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 050 – 2025

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND CONDUCT SUMMER YOUTH CAMP IN EVERY BARANGAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAVINTI AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it is a declared state policy under the Philippine Constitution to recognize the vital role of the youth in nation building and to promote their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social wellbeing;

WHEREAS, it shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the State to inculcate in the youth the values of patriotism and service to others through programs that are designed to develop in them leaderships skills, a sense of responsibility and stewardship of the environment, a dutiful awareness of their role in the building of safe communities, a love for sports and an appreciation of the importance of pursuing a healthy lifestyle;

WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No. 603, the Child and Youth Welfare Code recognizes the child as one of the most important assets of the nation and

not a mere creature of the State. With this principle, every effort should be exerted to promote the children's welfare and enhance their opportunities for a useful and happy life by cultivating their individual traits and aptitudes;

WHEREAS, upon the passage of **Republic Act No. 11910** better known as **Summer Youth Camp Act of 2022**, that a summer youth camp shall be conducted in every Barangay in venues chosen by the **Sangguniang Kabataan (SK)** of the respective local government unit to inculcate a sense of social responsibility, ingrain patriotism in the consciousness of the youth, develop youth leadership and mental health wellness, engage in livelihood and entrepreneurship activities, and promote active participation in sports and cultural awareness.

IN VIEW THEREOF, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan:


SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE . This Ordinance shall be called and to be known as "SUMMER YOUTH CAMP ORDINANCE OF CAVINTI."


SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. In this Ordinance, The Term:

- a. **Summer Youth Camp** – includes any regularly scheduled program or organized group activity advertised as a camp or operated only during school vacations or in weekends by a person, partnership, corporation, association, or an agency under the local government for recreational or educational purposes, and accommodating for propit or under philanthropic or charitable auspices five (5) or more children , who are under eighteen (18) years of age and who are not bona fide personal guest in the private home or an individual, and living apart from their relatives, parents, or legal guardian, for a period of two (2) days or more per week or portions of two (2) or more days per week, provided any such relative, parent, or guardian who is an employee of such camp no to be considered to be in the position of loco parentis to such employer's child for the purposes of this ordinance;
- b. **Sangguniang Kabataan** - is the country's Barangay Youth councils, aimed at developing and promoting programs and activities that cater to the youth's needs. The council is seen as a platform for emerging leaders to hone their skills in public service.
- c. **Youth** – as defined in Republic Act 8044 otherwise known as The Youth in Nation Building Act of 1995 and for the purpose of this ordinance, shall refer in those persons whose ages range from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years old;

SECTION 3. CONDUCTION OF SUMMER YOUTH CAMP. A summer youth camp shall be conducted in every barangay in the Municipality of Cavinti in venues chosen by the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) to inculcate a sense of social responsibility, ingrain patriotism in the consciousness of the youth, develop youth leadership and mental health wellness, engage and entrepreneurship activities, and promote active participation in sports and cultural awareness.

SECTION 4. ROLE OF THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OF CAVINTI. The Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) shall spearhead the planning, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of the summer youth camps in their respective jurisdictions. The SK shall perform the following:

- a. Choose the venue of the Summer Youth Camp;
- b. Coordinate with the concerned institutions such as the National Youth Commission (NYC), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Department of Health (DOH), Department of Information and Communication and Technology (DICT), Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), National Commission on Culture and the Arts (NCAA), Department of Tourism (DOT), and other concerned youth organizations and youth-oriented organizations;
- c. Engage qualified trainers, in consultation with the representatives from local educational institutions, who shall teach the youth the topics included in the courses provided for in Section 5 of RA 11910;
- d. Provide a comprehensive report not later than thirty (30) days after the conduct of the summer youth camp, detailing its preparation, conduct, and outcomes and/or accomplishments to be submitted and reviewed by the Local Youth Development Office; and
- e. Evaluate the program, identify areas for improvement through engagement with participants, and submit proposals to the NYC.

SECTION 5. COURSES. The NYC, SK, representatives from the local educational institutions, the Local Youth Development Office, in close consultation with the Katipunan ng Kabataan, shall develop modules on the following courses:

- a. National situation on issues and current events impacting the youth;
- b. Leadership seminar on communication and teambuilding, conflict management, safe and inclusive environments, decision-making, healthy leadership, and parliamentary procedures;
- c. Workshop creative writing conference and seminars on research, editing, illustration, and publication;
- d. Public speaking on interpersonal communication, motivational speeches, persuasive speaking, technical presentations, public relations, debate, and group discussions;

- e. Sports and fitness that shall include strengthening and conditioning, physical education, competitive sports, indigenous games, sports coaching, and psychology;
- f. Mental wellness related to mental issues, youth pregnancy, adolescent sex, reproductive health, and other challenges facing the youth;
- g. Digital skills development, including training for the use of virtual applications and responsible use of social media;
- h. Industries of the future, including Artificial Intelligence (AI), Robotics, Blockchain, Metaverse, Electronic commerce (E-Commerce), and their practical application in agriculture, social life, climate change mitigation, smart buildings, and smart communities;
- i. Entrepreneurship and livelihood skills training applicable for both rural and urban setting;
- j. Environmental awareness, including disaster awareness, preparedness and mitigation, environmental protection, conservation, and sustainability;
- k. Human rights promotion, peace and security building, and crime prevention which shall include awareness of illicit drugs and substances;
- l. Financial Education, including basics of budgeting, savings, and investments;
- m. Personal development that shall include building a successful career roadmap; and
- n. Cultural awareness to foster culture-based empowerment, leadership, and governance among the youth.


SECTION 6. ASSISTANCE OF CONCERNED GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHER INSTITUTION. The NYC, DILG, DTI, DOH, DICT, PSC, NCCA, DOT, DEPED, The Municipality of Cavinti thru the Local Youth Development Office and other concerned agencies, shall provide the necessary assistance to the Sangguniang Kabataan of Cavinti for the effective implementation of the summer youth camp OF Cavinti.

The SK may also consult non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and civil society organization (CSO) accredited by the Local Government of Cavinti thru the respective Sangguniang Bayan in the development and implementation of the program.

SECTION 7. FUNDING. The budget for the summer youth camp shall be included in the annual appropriation of the Nineteen (19) Sangguniang Kabataan of Cavinti in accordance of Section 20 (a) of Republic Act No. 10742. Otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015.

SECTION 8 . SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision or part thereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the provision not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.


SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive order, rules or regulations contrary to, or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and posted in Website/Social Media Account of the Municipality and other conspicuous places within the municipality.

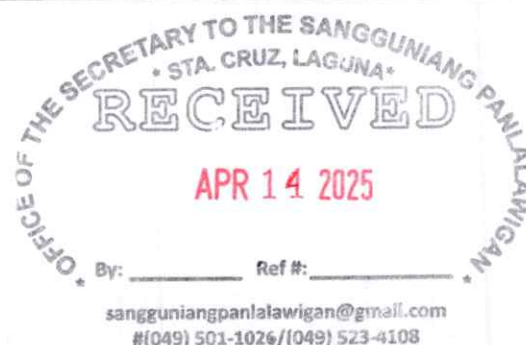


